But — a trapped horse can kill you!

Avoid becoming a statistic AND prevent your trapped horse from being strangled, drowned or dropped, or severely injured by incorrect rescue techniques.

Learn what you should do - and not do – if your horse is trapped in mud, floodwater, a ditch or gully, septic tank or swimming pool or an overturned horse float.

Learn how emergency responders should safely use the large surface area and skeletal strength of the horse's torso to prevent injury and increase the chance of a successful rescue.
